CODE OF CONDUCT

All individuals participating in Club activities and events are expected to abide by the following rules which establish a Code of Conduct for the Club. Immediate action may be taken by a Director if an individual fails to abide by these rules at the time of the violation if it happens during an event or a Club Meeting. Warnings will be issued for minor violations.

1. Any individual present at any venue where the Club is holding an event should respect the space. Do not litter or deface the property, equipment or other's property. Any trash accumulated during an event should be carried off the property unless there is a designated receptacle.
2. Respect a 10 mph speed limit on the property at 1037 Edmands Rd and park in designated areas.
3. Treat everyone with respect, on and off the field. Extreme or foul language, physical violence, bullying toward an individual and/or a dog will not be tolerated.
4. Treat your dog(s) respectfully and other dogs present with respect. Abuse will not be tolerated.
5. Dogs should be leashed and under control during an event unless they are running. Overly aggressive canine behavior is not acceptable. Practice before rounds should happen out of sight of the field. Dogs not running should not be distracting for competitors.
6. Social media posts and comments on pages for The Fetch Collective should be appropriate and reflect the Club's objectives
7. Club members and anyone participating in Club events should maintain a positive and encouraging attitude toward the Club's objectives.
8. No Smoking at the Field
9. Do not consume alcohol before or during game play. Alcohol should be consumed responsibly after game play and during a social event.
10. No cheating or bribery. No intentionally disrupting of another's round.
